- **Opening Announcements**
- **Introduction of Mayor Bill Euille.** The Alexandria City Council is composed of a Mayor, Vice Mayor and five City Council Members who are elected at-large and serve a three-year term of office. The Mayor, who is elected on a separate ballot, presides over City Council meetings and serves as the head of City government.
- **Remarks and Question and Answer Session with Mayor Euille.** What has the Mayor done to prevent crime in our community? What is the Mayor's position on the re-development of King Street and its surrounding communities? What can the city government – as opposed to the school board – do to improve the city's schools? What is the Mayor's reaction to the temporary closing of the Mirant Potomac River Generating Station? Bring your questions.
- **Starbuck's and a Day Care Center.** The City Council will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, September 20, 2005 at 4:00 p.m. to discuss two issues of potential interest to members:
 - 1767 KING STREET – a request for a special use permit to operate a coffee shop.
 - 1400 DUKE STREET – a request to open a child care center at this location.
